Assignment:

1. Sign in to the APES Google classroom!
2. Read Chapters 1 and 2 from *Environmental Science for AP** and submit it to the Google Classroom allow me to edit:
 - a. Answers to all “checkpoint questions”
 - b. Answers to “Do the Math” Problems (pp: 11 & 38)
 - c. Answers to all multiple choice questions at the ends of the chapters.
 - d. Definitions of (in your own words) all boldfaced words in the chapters.
 - e. Word-for-word what you consider to be the 10 most important sentences in **each** chapter. Write down the page number where you found the sentences
3. From the Earth Science Text (*Earth Science Geology, the Environment, and the Universe*) Read chapters 11, 12, 15, & 17 and answer the **Constructed Response** questions for each chapter.
4. [On this Google Doc](#): Sign up to watch ONE of the listed documentaries over the summer, while watching, come up with ten or more basic open ended (not yes/no) questions designed to demonstrate that you know what information from the documentary is important (think back to video questions you have seen in the past) Submit this on a separately shared Doc.
5. Choose another APES related documentary that you have NEVER SEEN and sign up on the [google doc](#). Watch this video and put together a presentation (slides, prezi, explain everything, etc) that will explain the subject of your documentary to your classmates and will link it to the APES curriculum (look in your book if need be). Share this with me as well. Be prepared to present the first day of class!
